## **Building Construction Notice**

**Subject:** 6<sup>th</sup> Edition (2017) Florida Building Code

The purpose of this notice is to inform the building industry that the 6th Edition (2017) Florida Building Codes will become effective on December 31, 2017. An analysis of the changes between the 2014 & 2017 codes with comparison tables for each of the codes (Building, Energy Conservation, Existing Building, Fuel Gas, Mechanical, Plumbing and Residential) can be found at the following link: www.floridabuilding.org/fbc/Links to Code Resources.html.

Also, the 2014 National Electrical Code will become effective on December 31, 2017. The new editions of the codes referenced above would be applicable to permit applications submitted on or after the effective date (i.e. December 31, 2017).

Please also note that all master plans approved by Charlotte County under the 5<sup>th</sup> Edition (2014) Florida Building Codes will expire on December 30, 2017 and cannot be used for permitting after that date. New master plans in compliance with the 6<sup>th</sup> Edition (2017) Florida Building Codes would need to be submitted for review and approval before being used.
